GLMRA YACHT MEASUREMENT DOCUMENT

(REVISED 03.01.24)

In addition to the measurements outlined in GLMRA's Rating Application, the weight of the yacht will be determined using the following guidelines:

1. Hatch boards and floor boards
2. Mast, boom, halyards, mast rotating system
3. All sails, specifically listed on the certificate: One mainsail, one jib, largest spinnaker, and screacher. Remove any undersized spinnakers, Code 0, etc. that is not specifically listed on the certificate.
4. Mainsheet system, and associated sheets and blocks for No 3 above.
5. Shrouds, forestay, furlers, bow pole
6. Fire extinguisher(s), outboard engine, tiller, bin covers.
7. Batteries permanently installed, but no more than two (2). This needs to be declared on the rating application, so it can be checked.

Not on boat:

1. All personal gear, clothing, foul weather gear, life jackets, etc....
2. Tools or tool boxes.
3. Anchor and anchor rode.
4. Fuel tank or fuel.
5. Any cushions.
6. Safety equipment. (Inconsistent on rating boats for offshore, long distance vs short buoy)
7. Mast raising equipment or any equipment used to rig the boat.
